Report Explain.

Leucocytosis

It occurs in bacterial infection, burn, post-operation, malignant tumor, leukemia, etc

Neutrophilia

It occurs in stress response or corticosteroid response, inflammation, granulocytic leukemia

Monocytosis

It occurs in stress response or corticosteroid response, bacterial/fungal/protozoal infections, immune-mediated diseases, paraneoplastic reactions (such as lymphoma), monocytic leukemia, etc

Atypical Lymph

Possible presence of atypical lymphocytes, and it occurs in juvenile animals, reactions after vaccination, virus/bacteria/parasite infection, allergy, drugs, and autoimmune diseases

Band cell suspected

Possible presence of band cells and/or toxic neutrophils, and it occurs in infection and inflammation
