Clinical significance:

cNT-proBNP is cleaved from BNP which is produced by canine cardiomyocytes and increases with excessive stretching of the cells. cNT-proBNP concentration reflects the severity of cardiac activation after stimulation (e.g. stretching) and is the optimal biomarker for diagnosis and rule out heart failure. Used for prognostic evaluation of heart failure and therapeutic efficacy monitoring. Increase indicates an increased risk of heart failure.
